

If you don't want 13000 houses on your doorstep take action today.

- **Did you know Kirklees is proposing to build 13000 houses in our area, many of them on green belt land?**

If you think this has nothing to do with you consider the impact it will have on where you live. There are currently only 1700 houses in Skelmanthorpe but we already have congested roads, a shortage of parking spaces and a lot of pressure on the essential services we all use. But, we have the pleasure of living in an area with some outstanding countryside.

Imagine what it would be like with three or four times as many houses and all the green spaces covered in housing estates. It would change everything that makes living here worthwhile. Yet that's exactly what Kirklees propose to do unless we make a concerted effort to stop them.

At the moment this proposal is one of five options Kirklees is considering in their quest to meet their target for 22000 new houses in the next few years. We can nip this idea in the bud if we all raise our protests now.
