Happy New Year, 'Things are happening'!

We are happy to report small but significant progress and success, through the pressure SCAG has been able to exert with various departments within KMC. This has been assisted by the support we have received from our local councillors.

- **Bovis Homes planned development on the 'old allotments' on Cumberworth Road.** A number of concessions have been obtained, including the number of dwellings to be built, pedestrian access onto Cumberworth Road, plus traffic calming measures to be introduced on Cumberworth Road. There are now highlighted issues of actual land ownership, and the matter of a culverted stream that runs under the site, which had originally been stated to be a sewer.
- Warning signs for Heavy Goods Vehicles are to be located at the Junction of Station Road and Commercial Road as well as the Emley end of Ley Lane, stating not suitable for Heavy Vehicles.
- We are in serious discussion regarding the traffic safety, congestion and speeding issues, in particular the junctions of Station Road, Commercial Road, Cumberworth Road and Huddersfield Road
- We have been able to implement the rebuilding of KMC Footpath 28, which runs adjacent to Station Road and Nobles Row and across the fields to Dawson's Mill. This work is currently under way, and should be completed early in this New Year.
